The Marco Antonio Firebaugh High School was built with concrete masonry that formed an aesthetic as well as functional base for the school and was used for durability and planning flexibility while maintaining community access to one of the few park sites left in the area.

Shot blast concrete masonry was selected as the dominant building material for its numerous benefits, which include safety, attractiveness, design flexibility, energy efficiency, durability, low maintenance, and speed of installation.

The use of concrete masonry units allowed the designers to add simple, but striking design elements at a lower cost. A final benefit is the fire resistant property of the material.
